- allowing for strong support relationships with donors and other governments with more advanced eGovernance programs.

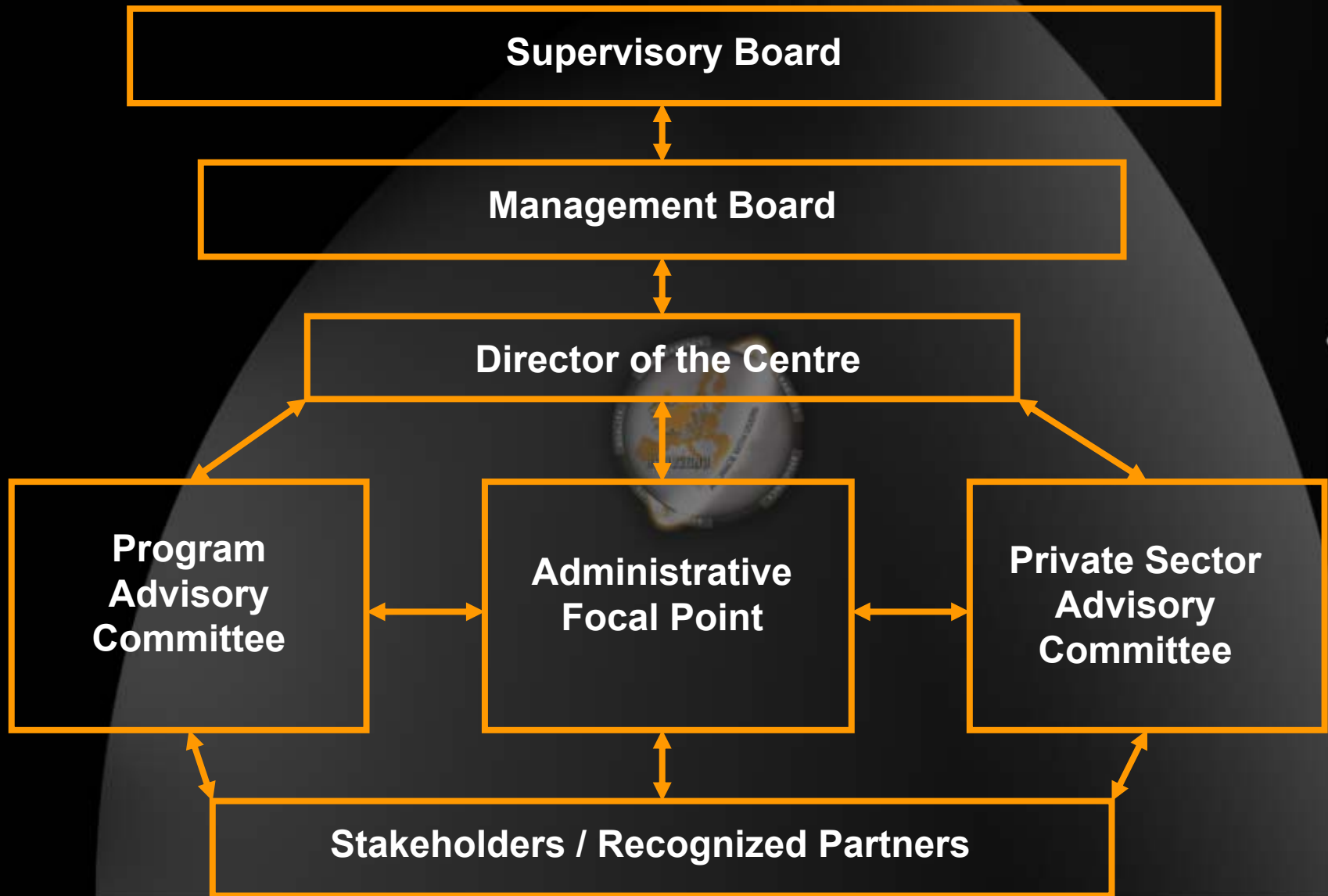
